Early Spring Service Information (Bermuda Lawn)

Safety: Pets can return to lawn once application is dry. Children should not play on treated areas until product has been watered in.

Weed Control: A post-emergent and a pre-emergent was applied. The post-emergent is applied as a liquid to existing weeds. The broadleaf weeds should begin to twist and curl within 10 days. Some species will decompose faster than others. Some species cannot be eliminated, only suppressed. We will also do our best to notify you if there is a species that needs special booster applications for a discounted rate. Hard to control weeds can be found on our website under our resources tab. Please contact us if you wish to apply additional chemicals to your lawn as it could hurt it.

Fertilizer: Potassium was applied to aid the roots as they begin to wake up for the new year. Please contact us if you wish to apply additional chemicals to your lawn as it could hurt it.

Watering: The treatment is rain-fast after 1-2 hours. However, please refrain from watering your lawn until 2-3 days after a treatment for absolute best results. Herbicide activity in a plant varies depending on weather and time of year. The amount you should water changes throughout the year. Through late March the lawn should be watered 1-2 times a week.

Mowing: Always try and wait 2-3 days to mow after a service. Failing to do so will hinder the herbicide from working at its fullest potential. The lawn needs to be scalped, bagged, and dethatched in March. Scalping is mowing the lawn at the mower's lowest setting. This helps the lawn become thicker and release better during green-up. This is also a great time to see how level your lawn is. If the lawn is bumpy and not corrected, it can cause your mower to stress the lawn in those high spots. A lawn can be made smooth by top-dressing. Call us for more info on this service.

Aeration: Aeration is very beneficial to a Bermuda lawn in the spring and fall. Please let us know if you are interested in this service and we can give you an estimate.
